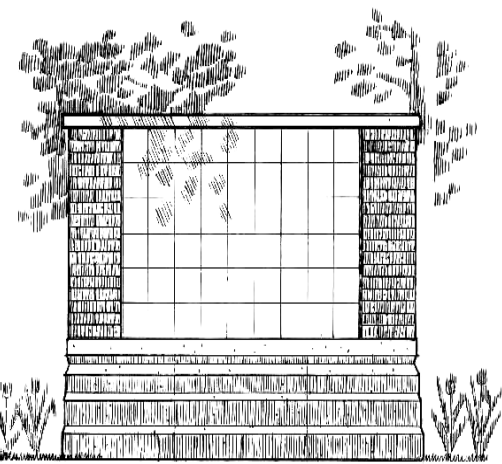

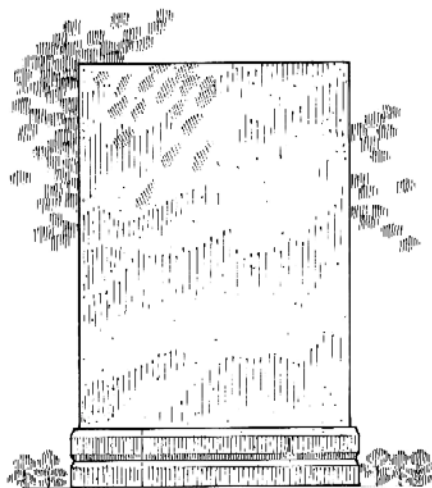
HISTORY

Our Memorial Prayer Garden with Columbarium and Memorial Wall has been requested for years by several St. Andrew Members, including some who's loved ones Ashes are already scattered in the area. Some who have worked for this project have died and their families await a niche. Several Memorial Fund gifts have been given for developing and landscaping The Garden.

The St. Andrew Congregation Council has approved The Memorial Prayer Garden plan and authorized the reservation and sale of niches. Policies for oversight, maintenance and care of the Garden have been set in place and copies are available.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Members of St. Andrew Lutheran Church, spouses or prior spouses, their children and parents, current or former pastors, and prior members are eligible to purchase a niche or have names engraved on The Memorial Wall.



Memorial Wall

The St. Andrew Memorial Prayer Garden is prepared for interring the remains of church members and loved ones in a place kept sacred for the remembering of those who have died, the Church Triumphant, by those who remain, the Church Militant! The Memorial Prayer Garden proclaims our Church's mission to be a caring community of saints who have gone before and those who grieve their death and bear witness to the gift of eternal life.

OUR MEMORIAL PRAYER GARDEN INCLUDES:

- A Columbarium – a beautifully constructed brick and stone wall of "niches" in which Ashes, or cremation remains, are placed in urns, and on which names and birth and death years are inscribed on the granite wall face.
- A Memorial Wall – a limestone base with a wall of granite for inscribing names and birth and death years of loved ones interred in a Scattering Site in the garden or elsewhere.
- A Scattering Site for the interring or scattering of cremation remains.

The Memorial Prayer Garden is located just east of the St. Andrew Sanctuary near the Patio Porch and the Church Bell. Funeral processions may carry Ashes from the Church to the Memorial Prayer Garden while the Church Bell is rung for each year of life and then placed or scattered with appropriate prayer as a part of the funeral or at a later date.

Loved ones may visit The Garden following regular congregational worship or whenever for prayer, meditation and remembering.

The Columbarium and The Memorial Wall are designed with limestone base and brick framework that match the Church exterior, thus connecting the "saints above and the saints below" in One Church.

The Niche Wall and the Memorial Wall are purchased from The Eickhoff Columbarium Company of Crookston, MN.

The professional landscape design will relate the Garden spaces with the Church landscaping and the surrounding natural setting. A beautiful Gazebo serves as a gathering place and a connecting point for Columbarium, Memorial Wall, and walking paths to the creek and pond areas, Resurrection Butterfly Gardens and Trails.

All funds will be held as Designated in The St. Andrew Lutheran Church Memorial Fund. Interment and Inscription Agreements will be prepared upon receipt of Reservations and Payment in full.
