

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER REGISTRATION

- † Shortly after registration, you will receive a confirmation letter via email confirming camp session, deposit received, balance due, and forms & payment due date.
- † For Youth Camps, you will receive a Parent/Camper Handbook in March, with all forms and details of camp. If your child's most recent physical exam was before June 1, 2007, you must see your doctor prior to attending camp. Now is a good time to make the appointment. ☺
- † All forms are due to St. Andrew by May 15 and final payments no later than one month prior to camp. We welcome early forms and payments!
